Sliding Scale Tuition

How to use this scale:

1. Identify your household size and household income. If your total household income falls between categories, round down to the category below.
2. Based on your total income and household size, identify which tuition scale you will use. *For example, a family of 5 that makes \$35,000/year would round down to the 100% category and would pay \$165/month for the full-time program.*
3. Submit documentation of your total household income (most recently filed federal income tax return - form 1040 or equivalent) and your last two paystubs via email to ECP@TheGLOBEAcademy.net or delivery to the Office. Documentation must be submitted yearly.
4. Sliding scale rates do not apply to enrichment programs as these are partnerships with vendors who determine the per student cost per class.
