Essential Functions: The following duties are representative for this position. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the classification if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment for this classification. Other duties may be required and assigned.

- Assist the lead Lower Campus physical education teacher in facilitating a standards-based curriculum, using a constructivist approach
- Function as a collaborative member of the entire Connections team (physical education, art, music, science, technology, and library)
- Serve as the lead Lower Campus physical education teacher in his or her absence
- Work with a wide variety of student abilities and learning styles
- Communicate and collaborate with teachers and administrators
- Participate in departmental meetings and professional learning opportunities

Qualifications

- Minimum of two years successful teaching or related experience at the early elementary school level
- Basic familiarity with [The Responsive Classroom](#) approach to teaching and discipline
- Ability to lift, transport, set up, and take down physical education equipment
