



Upper Elementary Spanish DLI Teacher

The GLOBE Academy is hiring a Lead Elementary Spanish DLI teacher.

Lead teachers have a 10-month position at [The GLOBE Academy](#), which houses grades K-3 at Lower Campus, and grades 4-5 at Upper Campus. The GLOBE Academy is a dual language immersion charter school serving approximately 1,070 students in Kindergarten - 8th Grade in the DeKalb County School District of Metro Atlanta, Georgia. With a focus on dual-language immersion, an experiential-learning model and a constructivist approach, GLOBE inspires students to be high-performing lifelong learners equipped to make a positive impact in the world.

Lead teachers should have a solid understanding of teaching in an experiential learning framework and have experience with the Workshop teaching model. Lead language teachers should be prepared to teach Language Arts, Science, Math, and Social Studies content in the target language. GLOBE Language teachers uphold 100% target language use with students at all times. Lead teachers encourage the use of the target language with students, and after a period of 100 days, have 100% language use by students in Kindergarten when responding to the teacher. After 50 days in first grade, the teacher facilitates 100% target language use by students to each other and to the teacher. From 2nd grade-5th grade, students only communicate in the target language when in language classes.

Professional Qualifications:

- Must hold or be eligible for Early Childhood Certification.
- Must have professional, academic proficiency in Spanish (Reading, Writing, Speaking, and Understanding/ Listening)
- Additional endorsements/certifications (Math, Reading, Gifted, ESOL, Special Education, Teachers College Reading and Writing workshop, Kagan Training) are a plus, and preference will be given to such candidates should they meet other important criteria and be a cultural fit with the school.
